A quality Chilean sparkling white wine, infused with handpicked strawberries to produce a refreshing and balanced sparkling wine, that's perfect as an alternative aperitif or a refreshing after-dinner pick-me-up.

Macabeo, El Muro, Aragon, Spain 15

An easy-drinking wine from Spain that's a great Pinot Grigio alternative. Macabeo is a grape that has elegance and freshness; aromatic floral notes with citrus and melon.

Glass £ 4.5 **Bottle** £ 17

Pinot Grigio, Conto Vecchio, Veneto, Italy 15

Not your average Pinot Grigio, this aromatic artisan wine from the north of Italy is packed full of flavour and is a hugely versatile food match.

Chardonnay Torrontes, El Collectivo, Mendoza, Argentina 15

The classic flavours of Chardonnay are paired with the aromatics of the local Argentinian Torrontes grape to produce harmony and balance.

Furmint Pinot Blanc 'Gomila', P&F Wineries, Slovenia 15

The local dry and crisp Furmint grape is given more depth and aroma when blended with the more delicately perfumed Pinot Blanc. A crisp yet fruity taste, with flavours of citrus fruit, apple and pear.

Gavi, Tuffolo, Piemonte, Italy 15

Situated in the heart of Piemonte in Gavi, the winemaking team at Tuffolo create wines to fit modern tastes from this famously traditional Italian wine region.

Sauvignon Blanc 'Satellite', Spy Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand 16

This wine is a real hit and a true classic Marlborough Sauvignon, with flavours of lime, grass, gooseberry and aromatic flowers.

Riesling 'Kung Fu Girl', Charles Smith, Washington, USA 14

This is not another fruity German style Riesling... it's smooth and aromatic with flavours of apricot, key lime and nectarine. Medium-bodied, with a crisp, long, dry finish.

Montagny 1er Cru, Domaine Alain Roy, Burgundy, France 13

A proper Burgundy wine, this baby Montrachet has the depth and elegance to punch above its weight. This softly oaked Chardonnay retains lots of freshness and deep mineral characters.

Roero Arneis, Vietti, Piemonte, Italy 15

An unoaked, dry, medium bodied white wine with crisp acidity. This Arneis is well-balanced and elegant with good complexity and a lingering finish.

Crozes Hermitage 'Mule Blanche', Paul Jaboulet, Rhone, France 14

Paul Jaboulet is a legend in the Rhone making some of the clearest expressions of the terroir of the region, and this, his 'Mule Blanche' is no different. Simply exquisite.

Rosé

Pinot Grigio, Conto Vecchio, Veneto, Italy 15

A very decent rosé from the Pinot Grigio grape, light and floral with a pleasantly balanced fruity and crisp palate. The colour is light and very Provence-like.

Provence Rosé, Cuvee de l'Aubade, Provence, France 15

This is the classical Provencal rosé in the classic rosé bottle; and for the fan of Provence, this wine will not disappoint... elegant and floral with a lingering citrus freshness.

Red

Negroamaro, Ponte Miliano, Puglia, Italy 15

Negroamaro is a local grape from Puglia that's really rising in prominence. It's an easy-drinking medium-bodied red that's full of flavours of red cherries and raspberries.

Carmenere, Lorosco, Central Valley, Chile 15

Plush and full bodied, yet silky smooth, this is the famous Carmenere grape from Chile that makes wines of such distinction.

Pinot Noir, Les Nuages, Loire, France 15

An amazing light-bodied Pinot Noir from the Loire Valley that's packed full of aromas and flavours of redcurrants and cherries, with a long smooth mouthfeel.

Bobal de San Juan, Cherubino, Valencia, Spain 14

Spain is not just Rioja and this wine is clear proof. Bobal is the grape of choice in Valencia and it produces smooth, fruity yet spicy red wines with cherry and blackberry notes.

Shiraz Mourvedre, Journey's End, Stellenbosch, South Africa 15

A typically bold and flavoursome South African red wine that's packed full of peppery spices, darker black fruits and eucalyptus notes.

Barberesco, Riva Leone, Piemonte, Italy 12

The quality and reputation of Barberesco is phenomenal, and this wine from the Nebbiolo grape is elegant, sophisticated and smooth with flavours of juicy cherries and bitter almond.

Les Alleees de Cantemerle, Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France 12

This, the second wine of Chateau Cantemerle is a very approachable and drinkable Bordeaux, generous with the classical flavours of cedar and cassis.

Pinot Noir, Josef Chromy, Tasmania, Australia 15

An amazingly elegant and characterful Pinot Noir from Tasmania that's a real rival to New Zealand. Sweet fruit and subtle savoury tannins provide an elegant, supple and long finish.
