## Sparkling

Pink Moscato, Innocent Bystander, Yarra, Valley Australia  
*Intense, primary aromatic of cotton candy and blackcurrant with musk, Turkish delight and mandarin peel in the background.*



Prosecco Extra Dry, Cantina Colli Euganei, Valdobbiadene, Veneto, Italy  
*Aromas are fresh and fruity with floral hints. Soft and lively on the palate without being aggressive. An excellent aperitif.*



Devaux Brut Reserve, Champagne France  
*The wine has a lovely Pinot Noir richness on the nose, with aromas of baked apples and vanilla.*



## White

Grenache Blanc, Petit Papillon, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 17  
*Delightful and fresh with aromas and flavours of peach and pineapple along with fresh almonds and white flowers. Very refreshing.*



Chenin Blanc, AcaciaTree, Western Cape, South Africa 17  
*Fresh, crisp and easy-drinking like a good Sauvignon Blanc but with more pear and apple flavours.*



Pinot Grigio, Conto Vecchio, Veneto, Italy 17  
*Not a standard Pinot Grigio, this easy-drinking Italian is a sure winner and a great all rounder.*



Chardonnay Torrontes, El Colectivo, Mendoza, Argentina 16  
*Classically Chardonnay yet with the aromatics of the local Argentinian Torrontes grape.*



Viognier, Le Versant, Languedoc, France 16  
*Soft, smooth, tropical and aromatic; Viognier is the perfect food matching wine for spicier dishes.*
